An official transcript typically has "Official" noted within the document, whereas an unofficial transcript typically has "Unofficial" noted within the document. Submission of an unofficial transcript or class schedule will disqualify you.
- Letter of acceptance or proof of enrollment to the institution you plan to attend  
If you are a new applicant, please upload a copy of your letter/email of acceptance to the institution you plan to attend. If you are selected to receive a scholarship from the Foundation, and the scholarship is not limited to specific institution(s), you may change your preferred institution by notifying the Foundation in writing. If you are currently enrolled in college or a renewal applicant, please upload proof of enrollment which may include a copy of your transcript, letter confirming enrollment, or a class schedule.
- 2018-2019 Student Aid Report (SAR) furnished by the U.S. Department of Education  
Please complete your 2018-2019 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and then upload a copy of your Student Aid Report (SAR) furnished by the U.S. Department of Education.
