- You must apply for your credit and have approval before making your charitable gift
- Gifts must be made to a permanent endowment fund at a qualified community foundation, its affiliate foundation or a county-specific fund
- The tax credit is up to 20% of the charitable gift (Example: a \$5,000 charitable gift would provide a \$1,000 credit)
- Maximum credit per taxpayer is \$10,000 (20% of \$50,000 = \$10,000)
- The tax credit is not refundable, but may be carried forward up to 5 years

ENDOW KENTUCKY TAX CREDIT

By making a gift to a new or existing permanent endowment fund at the Community Foundation, you may qualify for a state tax credit and a Federal tax deduction. This is a tax-wise way to create a lasting legacy and support Kentucky charities, counties or communities forever.

TAX CREDIT VS. TAX DEDUCTION

Endow Kentucky features a tax **credit**, which is different than a tax deduction. A tax deduction reduces your taxable income, so the value depends on your income tax bracket. A tax credit lowers your tax bill dollar for dollar, no matter your tax bracket.

LIMITED OPPORTUNITY

State tax credits are available to individuals and corporations on a first-come, first-served basis beginning **July 1, 2022**. To be eligible for the Endow Kentucky tax credit, you must receive prior approval through the Kentucky Department of Revenue before your charitable gift is made. If you are considering a charitable gift that may be eligible for the tax credit, we encourage you to contact us today.

HOW TO APPLY

- 1.Contact Jennifer Fust-Rutherford at the Community Foundation of Louisville to obtain an application pre-printed with certain required information.
- Complete, sign and submit the application to Jennifer before June
 29, 2022. We will file the application for you.
- 3. Following a review by the Department of Revenue, a Preliminary Authorization Letter will be issued to you.
- 4. You will have 30 days from the date of the Preliminary Authorization to make your gift to the Community Foundation of Louisville for your chosen fund.
- 5. Within 10 days of receiving your gift, the Community Foundation of Louisville will complete a Schedule ENDOW on your behalf and file it with the Department of Revenue as proof of your charitable gift.
- 6.The Department of Revenue will review the Schedule ENDOW and send a final, approved Schedule Endow to you for your tax records.
