SCCF was organized in 1995 to provide the services of a community foundation to local residents and to begin building a collective charitable endowment for Shelby County. This endowment fund supports local organizations annually through a competitive grant making program. In 2021, the Foundation granted \$200,000 to 17 local nonprofit organizations.

The Shelby County Community Foundation is an affiliate foundation of the Community Foundation of Louisville, a tax-exempt public charity that administers charitable funds created by individuals, businesses and organizations for the betterment of their communities.
