The Shelby County Community Foundation (SCCF) is dedicated to enriching the quality of life for all the citizens of Shelby County by serving the charitable interests of donors who have established charitable Funds as a part of a permanent, collective, philanthropic resource for the current and future needs of the Shelby County community.

SCCF was organized in 1995 to provide the services of a community foundation to local residents and to begin building a collective charitable endowment for Shelby County. This endowment Fund supports local organizations annually through a competitive grant making program. In 2023, the Foundation granted \$204,700 to 23 local nonprofit organizations.

The Shelby County Community Foundation is an affiliate foundation of the Community Foundation of Louisville, a tax-exempt public charity that administers charitable Funds created by individuals, businesses, and organizations for the betterment of their communities.
