### **UPS Louisville Community Care Fund Information + Process**

#### **Summary**

**The UPS Louisville Community Care Fund** supports nonprofit organizations working to meet critical needs and strengthen communities across Louisville. The Fund is managed in partnership with the Community Foundation of Louisville and builds on The UPS Foundation's commitment to helping safe, healthy, and resilient communities thrive. Eligible applicants may request up to \$150,000 for a new or existing project or program.

#### **What is the Fund's focus?**

This grant opportunity will support nonprofit organizations focused on disaster relief, education, environmental resilience, first responder support, and mental wellness.

#### **Eligible applicants include organizations, projects, and programs that are:**

- 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations, or fiscally sponsored projects of 501(c)(3) entities
- Located in the Louisville Metro area or Southern Indiana. For the purposes of this grant, the Louisville Metro area includes Jefferson, Oldham, Shelby, Spencer, and Bullitt counties in Kentucky, and Clark, Floyd, and Harrison counties in Indiana

#### **Who makes the grant selections?**

Applications are reviewed by an advisory group assembled by The UPS Foundation and the Community Foundation of Louisville.
