Who is the Shelby County Community Foundation?

The Shelby County Community Foundation (SCCF) was organized in 1995 as an affiliate of the Community Foundation of Louisville (CFL). Our organization aims to provide the services of a community foundation to local residents and to begin building a collective charitable endowment for Shelby County.

SCCF is part of a tax-exempt public charity that administers charitable funds created by Kentucky residents, businesses, and organizations for the betterment of their communities. Through programs like **Endow Kentucky Tax Credit** and **Give for Good Louisville** consistently supporting nonprofit organizations of Shelby County, charitable dollars make an even greater impact in our community.

Our mission also involves the encouragement of civic-minded Shelby County residents to add to our collective endowment by creating funds that support their charitable interests. **Charitable giving accounts** help simplify your philanthropy with a gift of any amount. **A permanently endowed fund** may be created with a gift of \$10,000 or more. Funds may be established by a lump sum, periodic gifts, or a bequest through a will. Donors may also create funds that pay income to a charity in perpetuity, ensuring the longevity of their impact.

We are fortunate to be an affiliate of CFL, which possess the administrative, financial, and legal expertise to manage its significant holdings of \$1 billion. Investing your funds with CFL means **maximizing your gift's impact** with a larger investment.

To make a difference in Shelby County now and after your lifetime, I encourage you to join other Shelby County residents in considering the services available through both the Shelby County Community Foundation and the Community Foundation of Louisville.

Funds at the Shelby County Community Foundation

Shelby County Partnership Grants Fund

The Shelby County Partnership Grants Fund provides support to nonprofit organizations that support Shelby County and its residents. Grants from this fund are made possible by dozens of generous supporters.

Designated Funds

Donors create designated funds to provide permanent support for specific non-profit organizations. Other donors may contribute to these funds at any time. Requires a \$25,000 minimum.

Field of Interest Funds

Donors create field of interest funds to support a broad area of charitable interest or a geographic area for which they have a particular concern. Requires a \$25,000 minimum.

Scholarship Funds

Donors establish scholarship funds to help students achieve their educational goals. Donors may establish the criteria to be applied for selecting recipients. Requires a \$25,000 minimum

Nonprofit Organization Funds

Charitable organizations may place endowments with the Community Foundation as a way to protect those funds for each organization's future. Requires a \$25,000 minimum.

Donor Advised Funds

A charitable giving tool that combines maximum tax benefits with the flexibility to support your favorite charities at any time. Requires a \$10,000 minimum.

Bequests and Beneficiary Designations

Donors plan future endowment funds with a bequest through a Will or Trust, or name the Community Foundation as the beneficiary of a retirement plan or insurance policy. Various minimums required.

Lasting Ways to Benefit Our Community

You can give to an existing fund or establish an endowment fund that is customized to achieve your charitable goals. Funds are invested and a portion is available to be used for grants, ensuring that your charitable legacy can last forever.
